<u>Parent/Child Aquatics</u> Developed for children 6 months to 3 years, Parent and Child Aquatics helps young children get ready to swim by emphasizing fin in the water. Parents and children participate in several guided practice sessions that help kids learn elementary skills, including water entry, bubble blowing, front kicking, back floating, underwater exploration and more.

Level 1, children learn basic skills through fun activities, such as blowing bubbles and playing with water toys.

Level 2, parents work with their children to practice floating, kicking and swimming back to the side of the pool.

Limit 10 per class

<u>Pre-School Aquatics</u> Children ages 4 and 5 learn water safety, survival skills and foundational swimming concepts in a safe and fun environment. Skills are age-appropriate, allowing students to achieve success on a regular basis.


