# AQUATIC CENTER - SWIM LESSONS & POOL RULES <sup>2</sup>

411 EAST HOLTON ST., 374-7446

**Parent/Child Aquatics** 6 mo to 3 yrs, Parent and Child Aquatics helps young children get ready to swim by emphasizing fun in the water. Parents and children participate in several guided practice sessions that help kids learning elementary skills.

Level 1, children learn basic skills through fun activities, such as blowing bubbles and playing with water toys.

Level 2, parents work with their children to practice floating, kicking and swimming back to the side of the pool.

\*Limit 10 per class\*

**Pre-School Aquatics** 4 & 5 yrs, Learn water safety, survival skills and foundational swimming concepts in a safe and fun environment. Skills are age-appropriate, allowing students to achieve success on a regular basis.

Level 1, helps children become comfortable in the water and basic water safety.

Level 2, build on level 1 and introduces fundamentals skills, such as kicking.

Level 3, focuses on coordinating arm and leg movements and improving upon skills learned in levels 1 and 2.

\*Limit 6 Per class\*

**Learn to Swim (LTS)** 6 yrs to Adult, Our six-level Learn-to-Swim program is unlike anything offered by other learn-to-swim programs. The program is designed for children 6 years all the way up to adults, and students progress through the levels at their own pace, mastering the skills in one level before advancing to the next. Each level of Learn-to-Swim includes training in basic water safety and helping others in an emergency, in addition to stroke development

## AQUATIC CENTER RULES & POLICIES

- If you plan to leave the pool and come back (same day), you will need to get your hand stamped by the pool attendant prior to leaving the facility
- Children ages 6 and under must be supervised by an adult at all times, and will not be allowed in the facility unless accompanied by an adult.
- The pool will close if there is heavy rainfall, danger of an electrical storm, is unusually cold outside, or due to lack of participants. Decisions for lessons will be made every half hour. Contact the pool at (608)374-7446 for further information. **Cancellation Hotline: 608-374-7449**
- Rain checks will be issued if the pool closes within the first hour of open swimming for any reason, otherwise there are NO daily admission refunds.
- Slides will close due to lack of staff or unruly behavior by participants.
- If a child has more than one time-out in a day, they will be removed from the pool with a phone call to the parents.

Each fall the Parks Dept. provides a limited number of trees to City Residents for the public boulevards. To request a tree fill out a form at the City Clerk's Office beginning in August

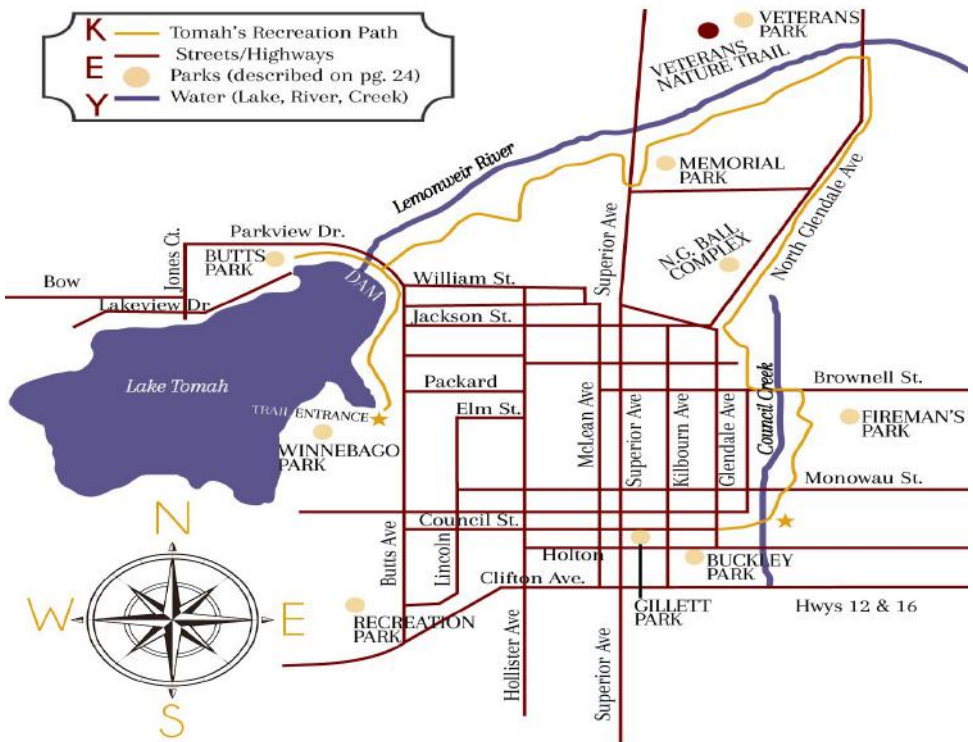
